

Manufactured Home Improvement and Repair (MHIR) Program **Home Repair Application Checklist**

This guide is designed to be a comprehensive checklist to guide you through the application process. Make sure you check off each item as you complete it to ensure you don't miss any steps.

General Tips:

- Always keep a backup of all the documents you submit.
- Regularly check your email and phone for any communication from the MHIR Program.
- Ensure you respond promptly to any questions or requests for additional information.
- Make sure your project meets eligibility requirements for habitability and health and safety repairs.
- Make sure you accurately describe why each repair is needed on your application.

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① Eligibility Verification:
Before you start the application process, ensure that you meet all the eligibility criteria for the MHIR Program:
\square You own the home, it's your primary residence, and is in a registered mobile home park in VT.
\square The repair will help you maintain your housing. It is addressing issues of habitability.
② Gather Documentation:
☐ Proof of Ownership:
This is typically a tax bill from the town. Other options: bill of sale, mortgage or home loan
statement, deed, will, or probate document.
☐ Project Summary:
Write a detailed description of the repair work required and your project timeline.
□ Quotes:
Obtain quotes for each component of the project from qualified contractors. (They must be
licensed if doing electrical or plumbing work.)
 Ensure that the quotes are detailed and itemized with the proper contact information.
 <u>Tip:</u> Multiple quotes may help in getting a competitive price.
• If doing the project yourself: Have a materials quote and details for the labor hours needed.
□ Pictures:
Take clear pictures of <u>each area</u> to be repaired showing the issue.
☐ Direct Deposit Information:
Go to the <u>Upload W9/Direct Deposit page</u> . Download, fill out, and submit a direct deposit form
with your information, but not the W-9. Submitting the forms does not guarantee funding. It
expedites payment <u>if approved.</u>
